Singer Information

About the Chorus: The Fountain Hills Community Chorus, comprised of approximately 75-100 men and women who sing in four-part harmony, was founded in 1991 by a group of Fountain Hills residents. The chorus is funded entirely from membership dues, concert ticket sales, grants, and donations and is part of the Fountain Hills Cultural and Civic Association (FHCCA), a local nonprofit organization.

Sessions: The Fall Session is from September through early December, and the Spring Session is from January through early April. Members are encouraged, but not required, to participate in both sessions.

Rehearsals: Weekly rehearsals are every Monday night from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Fountain Hills Community Center, 13001 N. La Montana Drive. Additionally, there is usually one section rehearsal and one stage rehearsal. See the Chorus Schedule for dates and alternate locations when the Community Center is closed for holidays. **PLEASE NOTE: Proof of vaccination are required for all registering singers for the Spring 2022 Session and masks are strongly recommended but not required. Concerts: The chorus presents holiday concerts in early December and spring concerts in late March or early April. See the Chorus Schedule for dates and times.

Additional performances: The chorus and small ensembles from the group also perform at community functions from time to time. Additional performances will be announced at rehearsals. All members are encouraged, but not required, to sing at additional performances as their personal schedules permit. Sign-up sheets will be on a table outside our rehearsal room.

Dues: All that is required to join the chorus is completion of a registration form and payment of the session's dues, currently \$40. Dues help cover expenses such as music, performance space rental, and salaries of our director, assistant director, and accompanist. There are no formal auditions, but musical experience is desired.

Attendance: Rehearsal absences are counted from, and include, the session's first rehearsal. The director, with the board, must approve more than three absences during a session.

Fountain Hills Chamber Singers: The Chamber Singers is an auditioned small group of singers from within the chorus that performs additional SATB music at our concerts. The group rehearses for one-half hour after the chorus' regular rehearsals. See the chorus schedule for audition and rehearsal dates.

Name Badges and Member Directories: Each chorus member receives a name badge to wear during rehearsals and a directory which includes members' contact information. Directories are made available only to chorus members; directory contact information may be used *only* for chorus-related activities.

Emergency Forms: There have been rare instances when chorus members have needed emergency medical attention. Chorus members are strongly urged to complete an emergency medical form, furnished by the chorus, and place it in the back pocket of his or her folder. This information is seen only by the member. If an emergency arises, the form will be given to emergency medical personnel. Forms will be available on a table outside our rehearsal room.

Board Meetings: The Chorus is guided by a board of directors which meets monthly. All chorus members are welcome to attend board meetings.
